A Leader in Arts Programming in NW Ohio Since 1999


Black Swamp Arts Council was born out of the vision to offer a wide range of arts opportunities, and make them accessible to everyone. For 25 years, we've been the foremost provider of, and advocate for, arts programming in rural NW Ohio.

In August, 2023, the Edward and Mildred Roth family gifted an historic building to become a permanent community arts center. The 2,500 sq. ft. space will allow us to expand our mission, serve more individuals, and provide a dedicated facility for people to discover engaging arts offerings. The center will draw people to downtown Archbold for classes, exhibits, and other creative events. A vibrant arts and culture scene enhances economic development and quality of life, particularly in underserved rural areas.

The building requires significant renovations to provide a functional, multipurpose, accessible arts space where area residents can explore and engage their artistry. Highlights of the facility include gallery, classroom and performance spaces, a kiln, ADA facilities, and room to host private arts functions.
